When the son returns, he begins stealing lobsters from Harper's traps, and Harper, out of a sense of obligation and guilt, teaches him to fish, vainly hoping it will help the man put together the pieces of a life that war shattered. In The Connoisseur, a wealthy collector on an archaeological dig in the Himalayan foothills realises he knows how to stay out of jail, charge rent, build hotels, and pass Go, but has not spiritual life. Unlike his guide, a Sherpa, who could remain content with nothing but the Himalayas, the collector finds himself wanting in all but material success. Whether they win or lose, Robert Abel s characters make the best of circumstance with creativity, wit, passion, and endurance....
