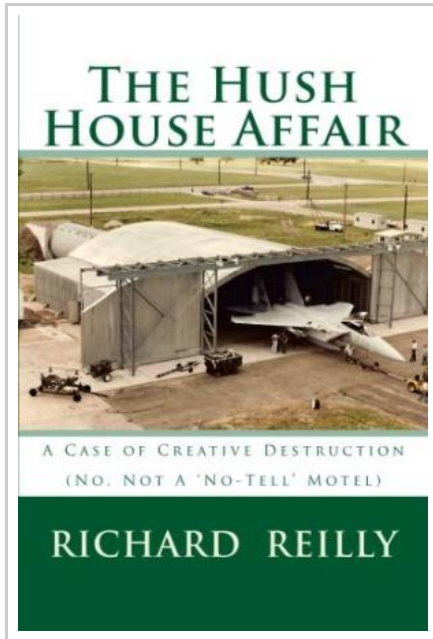




The Hush House Affair: Creative Destruction (Not A No Tell Motel)
