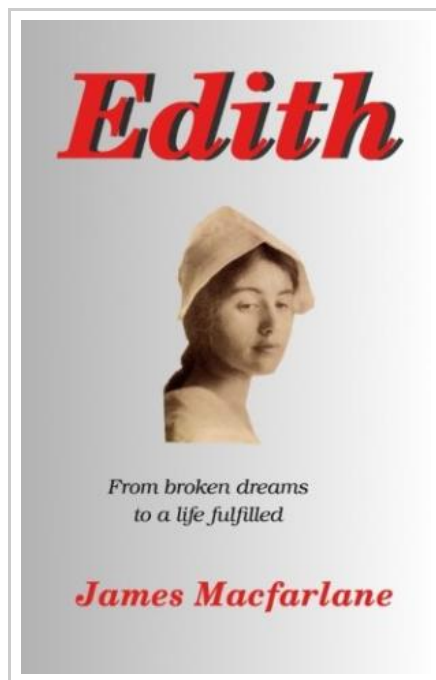




Edith (Paperback)
